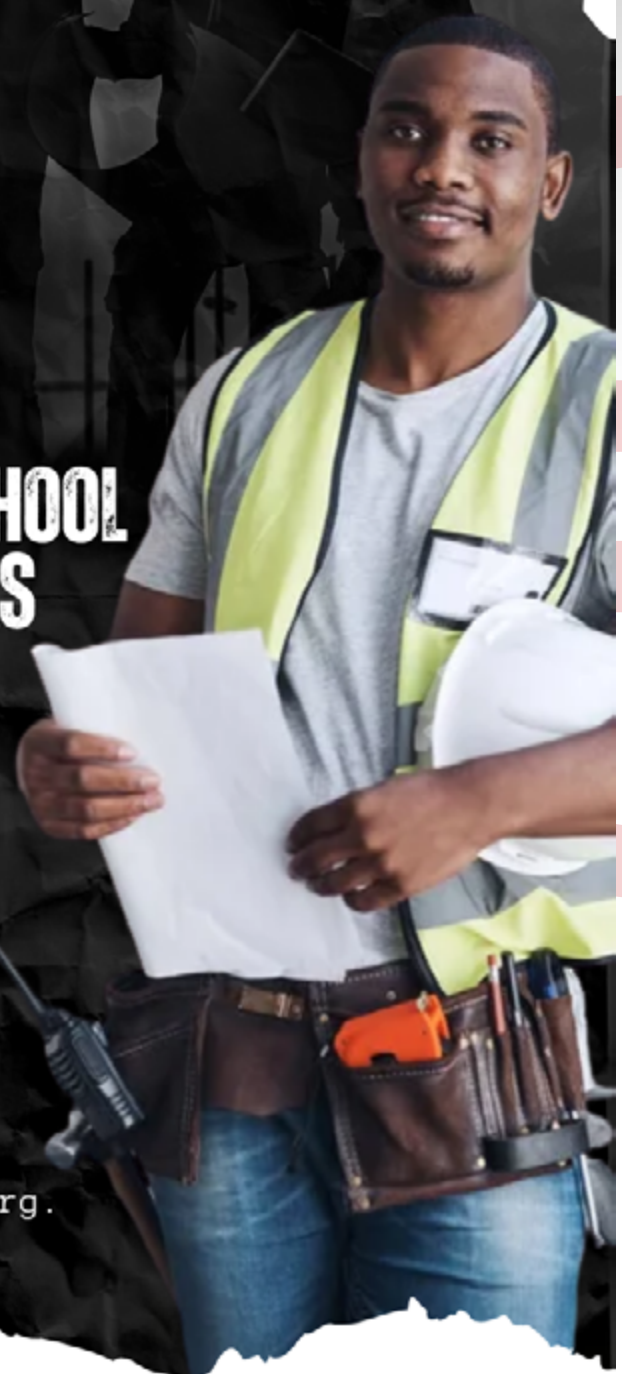

Our Mission



WORKFORCE & CAREER DEVELOPMENT

This program specializes in assessing and addressing barriers of individuals to increase their employability opportunities. We serve individuals who are unemployed, underemployed, seeking a career change, and previously or currently justice involved. This program helps strengthen the economic well-being of Oklahoma County's African American families and other families living in poverty by increasing sustainable employment that will lead to self-sufficiency and less dependent on government subsidies. We provide access to industry recognized certification, work readiness training, connections with employers with emphasis in high demand occupations.

EDUCATION & FAMILY DEVELOPMENT

This program specializes in supporting minority children to ensure success in school and development through achieving academic enrichment in subjects of science, literacy, technology, and math; social and personal skills development, and support to parents/caregivers by providing them tools to create environments and experiences that promote their child's academic success.

HOUSING & FINANCIAL LITERACY

This program provides information on financial skills (budgeting, credit counseling, and debt management) in order for our clients to improve financial and/or housing stability. We provide access to affordable housing through our rental properties and supportive services. Residents also receive financial coaching to develop money management skills in order to remain self-sufficient and independent. Offers affordable homes by rehabilitating existing structures and constructing new homes, and prepares families for homeownership by hosting home buyer essentials workshops and webinars.

SMALL BUSINESS

This program provides services such as start-up and expansion assistance to small businesses, minority owned businesses and those with disabilities. We provide networking and training and access to compete for corporate and government contracts and further resources to sustain your small business.

COMMUNITY CONVENING & SOCIAL JUSTICE

The Community Convening and Social Justice Department (CCSJ) works to close gaps related to social mobility and economic vitality for under-resourced communities. The department focuses on voter education and mobilization, criminal justice reform, police reform, economic development, and diversity and inclusion training. CCSJ hosts one of the largest Expungement Expos in the state helping clients gain access to better jobs and housing through the records expungement process.

Charles T. Battle is a Chandler, Oklahoma native who graduated with distinction from the University of Oklahoma before earning his Law Degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Law in 2009. While in law school, he received the Order of Solicitor's Award and the Kelly Beardslee Award for outstanding student in the OU Criminal Defense Clinic. Since entering practice, he has founded The Battle Law Firm, PLLC, where he focuses on personal injury, employment discrimination, and probate

law. He has also served as an administrative law judge for the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission, where he adjudicated employment matters for state employees.

He currently serves as Lead Referral Attorney for the Urban League of Greater Oklahoma City's Expungement Program, where he represents participants seeking to have criminal records sealed and helps recruit attorneys to support the program's mission.

He is licensed to practice in the United States District Courts for the Western, Northern, and Eastern Districts of Oklahoma, the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals, the Oklahoma Supreme Court, and all courts of the State of Oklahoma.

MR. JIMMY L. ROGERS Partnership in Excellence Award

Jimmy was born in Forrest City, Arkansas, and graduated from Forrest City High School in 1974. He attended the University of Oklahoma, earning a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism, Public Relations, and Advertising in 1979, where he played football under Coach Barry Switzer and was part of teams that won two national championships and three Big Eight championships.

He began his professional football career in 1979 with the Edmonton Eskimos of the Canadian Football League, winning a Grey Cup Championship, before joining the NFL's New Orleans Saints as a running back, wide receiver, and special teams player. He later played for the San Francisco 49ers, retiring from professional football in 1986. During his playing career, he also spoke to youth audiences on substance abuse prevention and the dangers of impaired driving.

Following football, Jimmy dedicated his career to youth advocacy and prevention work, serving as Outreach Coordinator at Second Chance Adolescent Chemical Dependency Center at Wetumka General Hospital, a school counselor in the Winner Circle Program under Eagle Ridge Institute, and later founding Ill Star Agency, Inc., focused on at-risk youth. He continued gang prevention and mentorship work with Youth Services of Oklahoma and Community Works and is currently involved in the "Ten Hurdles of Gang Brain Addiction" program.

His service has earned recognition including Special Teams Player of the Year (New Orleans Saints Touchdown Club, 1980–1982), Runner-Up NFL Man of the Year for Community Service (1981–1984), and Youth Care Professional of the Year (2011), along with ongoing youth coaching and community outreach.
